**1 DAY 1 — MONDAY, APRIL 26, 2027 —
DEPARTURE FROM THE UNITED STATES**

Your journey begins today as you depart from the United States on an overnight flight bound for Jordan. Sit back, relax, and prepare your heart and mind for a meaningful pilgrimage through the lands of the Bible. **Meals:** —

**2 DAY 2 — TUESDAY, APRIL 27, 2027 —
ARRIVAL IN AMMAN AND THE SHORES OF THE DEAD SEA**

Arrive in Amman and transfer to the Dead Sea. overnight at the hotel by the Dead Sea. **Meals:** D

**3 DAY 3 — WEDNESDAY, APRIL 28, 2027 —
MADABA, MOUNT NEBO, AND THE ROAD TO PETRA**

After breakfast and check-out, travel to Madaba to view its famous sixth-century Byzantine mosaic map of the Holy Land. Continue to Mount Nebo, where Moses looked out upon the Promised Land he would never enter. From there, journey south through Jordan's sweeping desert landscapes toward Petra. Dinner and overnight in Petra. **Meals:** B, D

**4 DAY 4 — THURSDAY, APRIL 29, 2027 —
PETRA, THE ROSE-RED CITY**

Today is devoted to Petra, the magnificent Nabatean city carved into rose-colored rock. Walk through the narrow Siq to the iconic Treasury, then continue exploring the vast archaeological wonders of this UNESCO World Heritage Site. Dinner at the hotel in Petra before returning to the Dead Sea for the night. **Meals:** B, L, D

**5 DAY 5 — FRIDAY, APRIL 30, 2027 —
CROSSING INTO ISRAEL: MASADA, QUMRAN, AND GALILEE**

After breakfast and check-out, cross the Allenby Border into Israel. Visit Masada, King Herod's dramatic cliff-top fortress overlooking the Dead Sea, ascending by cable car to explore its ancient ruins and the story of the Jewish rebels who once stood there. Continue to Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered, and, time permitting, to Ein Gedi, the desert oasis where David sought refuge from King Saul. The day concludes with dinner and overnight in Galilee. **Meals:** B, D

**6 DAY 6 — SATURDAY, MAY 1, 2027 —
NAZARETH AND MEGIDDO**

Today brings you to Nazareth, the town where Jesus spent His childhood and began His ministry. Visit the Synagogue Church, believed to be where Jesus read from the Book of Isaiah; Mary's Well, tied to the daily life of the Holy Family; and Mount Precipice, where the people of Nazareth once tried to cast Him from the cliff after rejecting His teaching. Continue to Megiddo, known as Armageddon, overlooking the fertile Jezreel Valley. An optional concert in Nazareth may be available this evening. Overnight in Galilee. **Meals:** B, D

**7 DAY 7 — SUNDAY, MAY 2, 2027 —
TEL DAN, BANIAS, AND THE BAPTISMAL SITE**

Travel north to Tel Dan and Banias, two of the principal sources of the Jordan River, and visit Caesarea Philippi, where Peter proclaimed Jesus as the Messiah. Continue through the striking landscapes of the Golan Heights, rich in both biblical history and panoramic beauty. The day concludes with a visit to the Baptismal Site on the Jordan River before returning to your hotel by the Sea of Galilee for dinner and overnight. **Meals:** B, D

**8 DAY 8 — MONDAY, MAY 3, 2027 —
ALONG THE SHORES OF THE SEA OF GALILEE**

This day is dedicated to the ministry of Jesus around the Sea of Galilee. Begin with a peaceful boat ride across the lake, then visit the Ancient Boat exhibit, Capernaum, Tabgha (site of the Primacy of Peter), and the Mount of Beatitudes. Enjoy a special St. Peter's lunch by the lakeside. Dinner and overnight by the Sea of Galilee. **Meals:** B, L, D

**9 DAY 9 — TUESDAY, MAY 4, 2027 —
MOUNT CARMEL, CAESAREA, AND THE ROAD TO JERUSALEM**

Begin your journey along the coastal plain, traveling to Mount Carmel to visit Muhraka, the traditional site of Elijah's confrontation with the prophets of Baal. Continue to Caesarea Maritima, the impressive Roman port city where St. Paul was imprisoned. After lunch, visit the Ayalon Institute, the historic bullet factory in Rehovot, before driving to Jerusalem. Check in to your hotel for dinner and overnight. **Meals:** B, D

**10 DAY 10 — WEDNESDAY, MAY 5, 2027 —
BETHLEHEM AND THE MOUNT OF OLIVES**

Travel to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity, the birthplace of Jesus, and Shepherds' Fields (Luke 2:1–20), followed by the Field of Boaz and Ruth. Continue to the Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of Jerusalem, walking down to Dominus Flevit and on to the Garden of Gethsemane. Overnight in Jerusalem. **Meals:** B, D

**11 DAY 11 — THURSDAY, MAY 6, 2027 —
JERUSALEM EXPLORATION: THE TEMPLE MOUNT AND THE CITY OF DAVID**

Visit the Temple Mount (subject to access), the Western Wall, and the Western Wall Tunnels. In the afternoon, continue to the City of David, walk the Pilgrimage Road, and visit the Davidson Center at the Southern Wall. Overnight in Jerusalem. **Meals:** B, D

**12 DAY 12 — FRIDAY, MAY 7, 2027 —
JERUSALEM EXPLORATION: YAD VASHEM AND MOUNT ZION**

Visit Yad Vashem, Israel's official memorial to the victims of the Holocaust, followed by the Israel Museum, home to the Shrine of the Book and its detailed model of Second Temple-period Jerusalem. Continue to Mount Zion to visit the Upper Room, Dormition Abbey, and St. Peter in Gallicantu. Overnight in Jerusalem. **Meals:** B, D

**13 DAY 13 — SATURDAY, MAY 8, 2027 —
THE OLD CITY AND THE GARDEN TOMB**

Explore the Old City of Jerusalem, entering through St. Stephen's Gate. Visit the Sisters of Zion Convent to see the ancient Roman pavement (Lithostrotos) and continue to Saint Anne's Church. Walk through the Old City to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, with time to reflect before concluding the day at the peaceful Garden Tomb. Overnight in Jerusalem. **Meals:** B, D

14 DAY 14 — SUNDAY, MAY 9, 2027 — DEPARTURE

Transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for your flight home, carrying with you unforgettable memories of your journey through the Holy Land and Jordan. **Meals:** B
